Welcome to Murton Equestrian Centre, our aim is for you to enjoy your time with us, to learn and have fun. We have been established since 1976 and are approved with the British Horse Society and The Association of British Riding Schools. We have a variety of school horses and ponies available for adults and children. We specialise in teaching people to ride at all levels including BHSAI. Lessons can be in groups or private lessons. We also offer stable management courses, hacks and jumping lessons. Our staff are fully trained, and BHS qualified. We have both indoor and outdoor riding arenas. The minimum age for riding is 4yrs and the maximum weight for adults is 13 stone.

BOOKING – To book your lesson simply phone or call in telling us of your experience and approximate height and weight. Bookings are usually made one week in advance, but we can sometimes take bookings at shorter notice. Unfortunately, we cannot accept bookings via e-mail. Payment will be taken at the time of booking.

CANCELLATION POLICY – please try to give as much notice as possible if you have to cancel a pre-paid booking. Cancellations less than 24hrs notice no refund can be given. Refunds will be offered provided we receive at least 24hrs notice. We regret that this will apply whatever the cause of the cancellation. We do not accept cancellations via e-mail.

CLOTHING – It is a good idea to bring a waterproof coat as lessons continue regardless of the weather. If you have not ridden before we suggest you wear comfortable leggings or loose fitting trousers, flat shoes with a small heel, or wellies. Riding hats can be hired. However, after your first few lessons it is advisable to purchase your own hat, which should be a minimum standard PAS 015 or BSEN 1384. A selection of hats and riding wear is available in our shop.

Riding Lessons

Walks are suitable for any beginners which have never ridden before or as a taster to give confidence. Instruction is given on basic position. Duration ½ hr

Leading reins classes are suitable for children aged over 6yrs or adult beginners. Riders begin on the leading rein learning to walk and trot in a correct position. Riders must be confident at walk and trot without a leader before they progress onto loose lessons. Duration ½ hr. Parents can lead or staff will lead horses (Cost £1)

Private lesson provide individual tuition for adults and children in basic riding. Lessons will be on or off the leading rein depending on your experience. Instruction is given on position, establishing your seat and canter. Dressage or Jumping is available for experienced riders. Duration ½ hr

Loose lessons are for groups of three who have mastered walk and trot. The lesson concentrates on reinforcing and practising prior knowledge. School movement and cantering are learnt and pupils then progress onto class lessons. Duration ½ hr

Class lessons are divided into junior, intermediate, senior and adult classes. They are graded according to the standard of rider. Junior classes are suitable for novices who can walk, trot and canter independently. Intermediate classes are suitable for pupils who are learning to ride without stirrups and have sufficient balance to carry out pole work. Senior lessons are for competent and experienced riders and may include pole work, jumping and hacking out during the summer months.

Hacks are available for experienced riders only and will be accompanied by an instructor. All riders must pass a Safety assessment prior to the hack.

Child and Adult stable management sessions are available on request. Teaching all aspects of horse care.

Own a pony day - These are held during the school holidays. The courses offered are all varying standards consult our notice-board for days and time. Children can choose which horse they would like to look after for the day. The children learn to muck out, feed, groom and care for the horse correctly.

Adult days – These are available during term time whilst the children are at school. Come and improve your riding and your stable management skills.

Birthday parties are available for children 6yrs and over on Saturday or Sunday at 4pm. A maximum of 12 children can be accommodated. Refreshments are available on request for an extra charge. Duration ¾ hr



Pony Club – membership to the pony club is £20 annually. Membership forms are available from reception. Please see the notice board for the range of activities and newsletter. Tests and badges can be taken by members in horse care.
